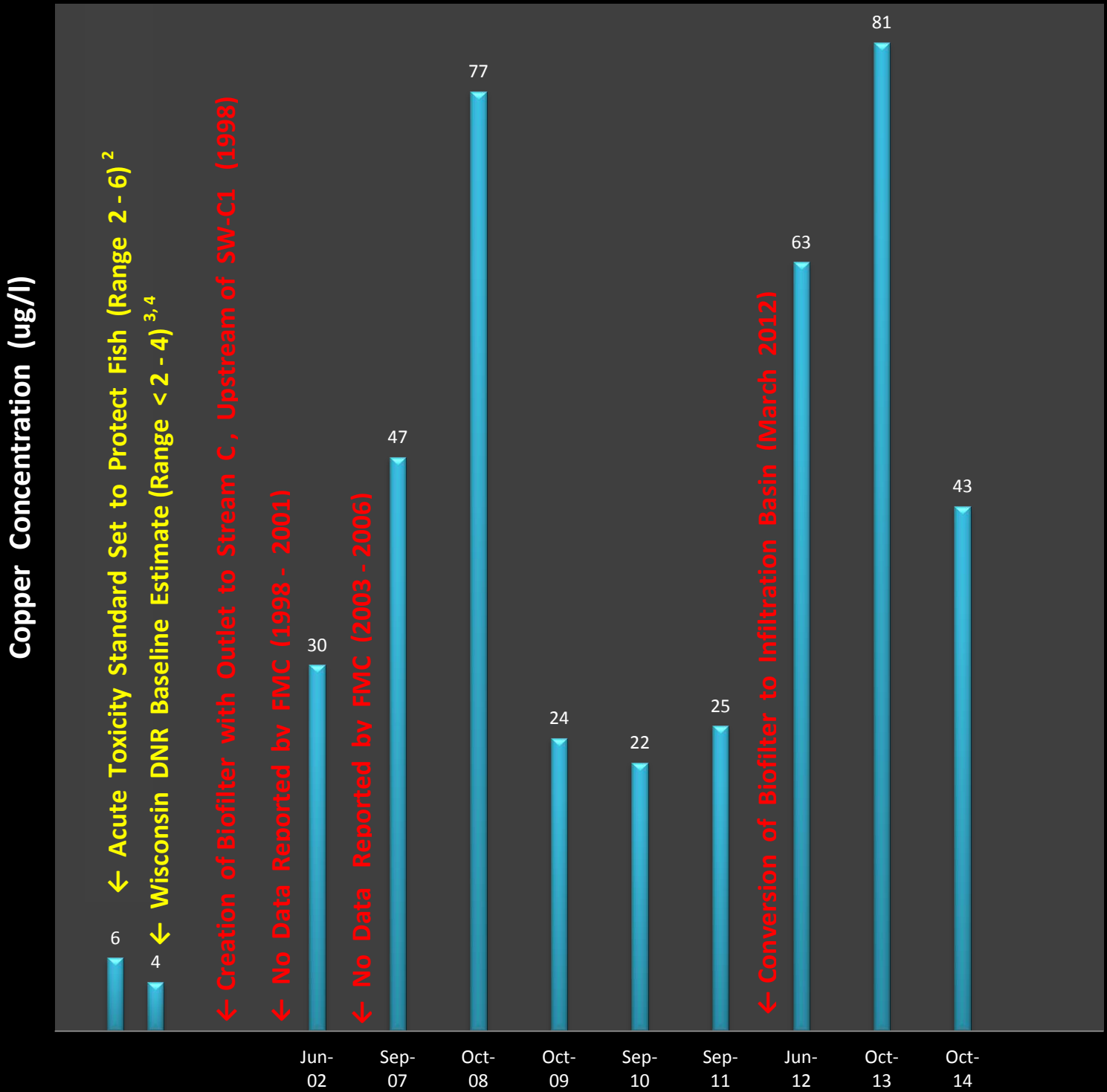


# Copper Levels in Stream C at the Flambeau Mine Site

Stream C is a tributary of the Flambeau River that flows across the southeast corner of the Flambeau Mine site.

Data shown below was reported by Flambeau Mining Company (FMC) for sampling site SW-C1, immediately downstream of the mine. According to FMC, SW-C1 is “representative of the water south of Copper Park Lane.”<sup>1</sup>
